Grant application guidance and conditions

- 1. Any requests made for schools grants funding can only be made by schools located within Kent.
- 2. Applications can be made by organisations from pre-school level right through to secondary schools.
- 3. Schools grant requests will only be considered where there is a clear educational benefit for students. Proposed project work or activities should specifically aim to improve students' understanding of wild mammals in Kent and should have a measurable output.
- 4. Applications are especially welcomed in relation to projects/activities which aim to contribute towards conservation of mammal species.
- 5. Recipients of schools grants are encouraged to provide the Kent Mammal Group with a write-up relating to the outputs of any funding received, which may be selected for publication on Kent Mammal Group's website, social media pages or in the biannual newsletter, *Quadrupedia*.
